OF STCW CONVENTION, AS AMENDED IN 2010

Notice is hereby given that on matters relating to issue of Certificate of Competency and Certificate of Proficiency issued to Seafarers in the Philippines in compliance to the requirements of STCW Convention, as amended in 2010:

- All Certificate of Competency under Regulation II/1, II/2, III/1, III/2, III/6 or Regulation IV and Certificate of Proficiency under Regulation II/4, II/5, III/4, III/5, III/7, Regulation V or Regulation VI issued by this Administration comply with the requirements of the STCW Convention, as amended in 2010.
- All Table of Competences under the STCW Code have been considered before any Philippine Certificate of Competency or Certificate of Proficiency is issued.
- Therefore, no further documentation of the successful participation in any approved training is needed, including Leadership and Teamworking Skills, High Voltage, Bridge Resource Management, Engine-room Resource Management, and Radar/ARPA.
